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
How to Add Reports to Your Dashboard

Once you put reports on your dashboard, you can access the reports anytime by clicking on the title of the report.

- Dashboards are created by the individual user and are therefore custom to your credentials. You can create your own.
- Click on your name in the upper righthand corner, then under user settings you can create your dashboard.

To add reports to your dashboard:

Step 1) Click on your username in the top right-hand corner.




Step 2) Click on Dashboard Reports.




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Step 3) Add all the reports you would like to have displayed on your dashboard (be sure to click the *Save Dashboard Reports* when you are done).



Step 4) Once you select Cento to take you back to the home page, the reports you added will be displayed on your dashboard. The registries you have at your site will determine what flash reports you have access to.




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How to Run a Report


There are two ways to run a report. If you click the run report button on the right, it will run the report without any parameters, and you will get the basic data. You can also right click on the title of a flash report and open it in a new tab, you will then see the contents of the report and can make any changes that you deem necessary before running the report (for example, time frame and participant names).



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


You can download the report in different formats, or filter the report as needed.



How to Filter a Report

An example of how to filter the Diagnostic Coronary Angiogrpahy Procedure [7045: DiagCorAngio] is to type "No" in the search box under the title.




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This will prompt the entire column to display "No".

Metrics and Measures

Metrics and measures in NCDR reports provide information on hospital and outpatient practice performance compared with aggregate benchmarks of all registry participants to guide internal quality improvement efforts. The NCDR follows the American College of Cardiology Foundation (ACC)/American Heart Association (AHA) classifications:

Performance Measures are those process, structure, efficiency, or outcome measures that have been developed using ACC/AHA methodology, including the process of public comment and peer review and which have been specifically designated as performance measures by the ACC/AHA Task Force on Performance Measures.

Quality Metrics are those measures that have been developed to support self-assessment and quality improvement at the provider, hospital, and/or healthcare system level.

 $Performance\ measures, endorsed\ by\ the\ ACC/AHA\ Task\ Force\ on\ Performance\ Measures\ and\ the\ National\ Quality\ Forum\ (NQF),$ are appropriate for consideration for additional\ quality\ programs, including\ public\ reporting\ and\ recognition\ programs\ by\ third\ parties.

Metrics and measures are developed with expert guidance using clinical guidelines (including guidelines developed by the ACCF in collaboration with other specialty societies) and evidence. In developing metrics and measures, the NCDR uses the leading methodology to identify and test metrics and measures that are scientifically valid and meaningful to providers for quality improvement benchmarking. When appropriate, this includes the development of composite metrics and risk-adjusted outcome metrics that can provide more usable information about quality of care than unadjusted individual metrics.



You can use the search bar to search for a report, or type control F to bring up the navigation box to search for specific words.




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
Link Back to Patient

While looking at the report, if you click the edit button on the far right of the patient, it will link back to the patient's tree (chart) and allow you to make changes if necessary. If you change information in the patient's data, it will be reflected in Cento immediately.



Report Filters

Report filters are listed above each report so you can see exactly what filters are being used.




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


Administration Tab

You can get flash reports depending on your permissions. If you have administrative permissions, you will see an administration tab on the top bar in Cento.




After clicking the administration tab, you will see the admin menu. If you click on *Manage Flash Reports* this shows you the list of registries that we have.



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You can check which reports you would like to use and uncheck the reports that you don't need.
